The Bible teaches us that confessing the word of God is vital to life in the Kingdom of God. Over 20 years ago I began confessing the word of God over my personal life each and every day – through that one principle I have seen many, many things change in my life.

Throughout my time in ministry, I have tried to impart to people how important their words really are, life and death are in the power of the tongue – whatever you say is what you will have – it is a principle of the word of God that works as surely as the law of gravity.

Many people are living under a curse of their own words – with our words, we bless or curse. While it is true that we are redeemed of the curse through the blood of Christ, we can find ourselves living with effects of the curse if we do not learn to watch our words. The Bible says our words will draw things to us.

The first thing we must stop doing is to stop speaking negative words over our life, our ministry, our jobs, our children, our spouses – for they will become what we call them. Once we accomplish that, our task becomes one of rebuilding. We do that with the word of God coming out of our mouth.

This book in your hands is a compilation of over 20 years of speaking the word over me and my family. It is a powerful tool with many hours of investment. I have scriptures on every subject I thought would be relevant to your personal life.

Apart from scripture references, I have included the Names of God, the Benefits of the Favor of the Lord, Specific Declarations and some of my personal confessions.

It is my deepest desire that you will take this book and bring your prayer life to a new level in God. That you will begin to speak the word of

God continually out of your mouth and begin to see a continual manifestation of those words.

The Bible says we can declare a thing and it will be established. It will. I have seen it happen over and over in my own life and in the lives of those around me. The Word does not fail. It never fails. If nothing but the word of God is coming out of your mouth – your circumstances will have no option but to line up with those words.

In this book, I have over 350 scriptures – they will change your life if you will apply them on a consistent basis. I have used numerous translations for these scriptures and I have made them personal. Most confessions do have scripture references but it may not read exactly like your personal Bible because I have used different translations and because I made them personal and present tense. Speak to your property and declare...

I call the buyers to come now, the contracts to be done quickly and without hindrance – I call you sold now, in Jesus name.***

Declare...

I ask You to bring the person who is to own this property to this exact location and/or lead me to the property over which You have purposed for me to own. ### **For Employment:**

Declare...

***I now dissolve and put aside all negative, limiting beliefs about where I will work and what kind of job is available to me. I open myself to all of God's possibilities. I call for a perfect, satisfying, well-paying job to manifest in my***

***life. I am always in the right place at the right time, for the Spirit of God directs my steps.***

**For Wisdom:**

***The Spirit of Truth abides in me and teaches me all things and guides me into all truths. Therefore, I confess I have perfect knowledge of every situation and every circumstance of life. The wisdom of God is formed within me. I trust in the Lord with all my heart and I lean not unto my own understanding.***

***I let the Word of Christ dwell in me richly in all wisdom. I do follow the Good Shepherd and the voice of a stranger, I will not follow.***

**To Pray Over Tithe:**
